

# Olympic High School Parking & Driving Guidelines

Please read completely though the OHS Parking and Driving Guidelines before signing below.

OHS Students are permitted to park on school premises as a matter of privilege; not of right.

**\*\*DUE TO LIMITED SPACE-PARKING PERMITS ARE ONLY AVAILABLE TO SENIORS AND JUNIORS FOR THE 2017/18 SCHOOL YEAR\*\***

## OHS Parking Permit Costs

- Students who drive motor vehicles to school must register (with a completed parking permit form), all vehicles and obtain parking permits through the Cashier's Office.
- A permit fee of **\$40.00** is charged for the permit. Permits must be displayed on the rear window of the vehicle.
- **Student parking is in front of the school in the upper SE corner from the stadium.**
- There is a **\$5.00** replacement fee for lost or stolen permits.

## Parking Violations/Tickets

- Cars improperly parked or lacking a permit will be fined **\$25.00, and possibly cuffed or towed at owner's expense for each violation.**
- Vehicles parked in the fire zone, bus zone, staff or visitor parking areas, handicapped parking, pool lot, East Alternative lot, or on the grass will be assessed a **\$25.00** fine for each incident.
- OHS students driving in the bus lane will be referred for disciplinary action and/or fined **\$25.00.**
- Fines will be issued to OHS students for speeding, careless driving, driving on grassy areas and driving the wrong way through one-way areas.
- Tickets will be placed on the windshield of a vehicle and the fine will be charged to the student's fine list at OHS. **Seniors may not participate in the commencement exercises unless all fines, including parking violations, are paid.**
- Students using a permit not issued to them will receive disciplinary action for theft and a **\$25.00 fine.**

## Vehicle Searches

- Olympic High School retains the authority to conduct routine patrols of student parking lots and inspections of the exteriors and visible interiors of student automobiles on school property. The interiors of student vehicles may be searched whenever a school official has reasonable cause or grounds for suspicion that the search will turn up evidence of the student(s) violating a school rule or violating the law. Police may be called.

Olympic High School is not responsible for theft or damage of cars. Students should report any such occurrences to the Main Office. With sufficient evidence, school officials may conduct an investigation or refer a specific incident to police.

**\*\*\*Students are not allowed in the parking lot during the school day\*\*\***
