

Chromebook return June 2018

If one of these statements describes you, your Chromebook should be returned in June:




- I am a **graduating senior**.
- I will be attending *FULL* time **Running Start** next year.
- I am **moving** out of Central Kitsap School District this summer. *Note: if you'll be attending a different CKSD high school (CKHS, KSS or BCCS) next year, you can keep your Chromebook.*
- I am **likely to move out** of Central Kitsap this summer.
- I will attend a Central Kitsap school next year, but I have an **extenuating circumstance**. I do not have an option to store the Chromebook myself. *Examples: I am traveling all summer, our house will be remodeled and we'll be in temporary housing, I will be with my Grandparents all summer who do not have WIFI, etc.* **Complete this form:** <https://tinyurl.com/returnCBohs>

When will I return my Chromebook:

Please make sure to return:

CHARGED Chromebook. In order to see if the Chromebook still works, it must be charged. (\$250 fine if Chromebook is not returned or in unrepairable condition)	
Both pieces of the charging cord. (\$25 fine if both pieces of cord are not returned or damaged)	
District issued case (\$25 fine is case is not returned or damaged beyond normal wear and tear)	

What will I do to return my Chromebook:

- **Clean** it at a cleaning station.
- Have library staff **scan** it.
- Have district technology staff **evaluate** it for damage. Fines will be assessed for damage (not all damage is covered by insurance).

What if I need a device AFTER that date:

- You may bring your personal computer to school and use it (while on school WIFI)
- You may use a Chromebook from the library (school use only)
- You may use a school laptop in class (school use only)

If you need a device *at home* and don't have a personal computer, please see Mrs. Cassel or Mr Wilson before you check-in your Chromebook.
