TESTING LOCATIONS:

- **Silverdale United Methodist Church:** 9982 Silverdale Way NW, Silverdale 98383. Located at the intersection of Ridgetop Blvd. and Silverdale Way. Test in gym
- **Teaching and Learning Center at Barker Creek:** 1400 NE McWilliams Road, Bremerton (at the corner of McWilliams and Highway 303, near Safeway)

TRANSPORTATION:

- **Students will ride an AP bus from the high school to their exam site** unless they've completed the driver's permission section on the AP permission slip. See Mrs. Cassel for more information. ***Please arrive for your bus early; the bus will not wait and hold up the exam, as we test with other schools in the district.**
- *ALL cell phones/electronics/smart watches will be collected before departure and will be held securely at OHS until the exam end. If you have 2 exams on the same day, you need to arrange your own transportation between your exams.*
- **For all morning tests, arrive at OHS for the bus promptly at 6:50 a.m. for arrival at the testing site by **7:15 AM**.** Buses will pick up students after the test and return students to school.
- **For all afternoon tests, meet at OHS for the bus promptly at 10:50 a.m. for arrival at the testing site by **11:15 AM**.** Buses will pick-up students after the test and return to the school.
- ***If driving yourself to the Church, the only place you can park is in the Kitsap Mall parking lot, closest to the church. Please, plan ahead and leave early.***

ATTENDANCE & LUNCH ON EXAM DAY-Attendance rosters will be sent to teachers each exam day

- **All A.M. Exam students will be excused from periods 1-4 only.** Students will take 3rd lunch when you return from testing at approx. 12:00 PM. ***Exception for Thursdays (Early Release schedule) A.M. students excused periods 1-5.***
- **All P.M. Exam students will be excused from periods 3-6 only.** Students will be released from 3rd per. at 10:30 to eat lunch before meeting for the bus at 10:50
- **Any other absences beyond the periods listed will need to be cleared by your parent/guardian.**

<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Bring:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ 3 sharpened #2 pencils (not mechanical)○ an eraser○ 3 pens in blue or black ink○ Picture ID○ up to 2 approved calculators for Calculus, Chemistry, Biology, and Statistics.● Dress appropriately; wear layers and dress comfortably● Be ON TIME! Once the test is started students will <u>not</u> be admitted to the testing site. There are <i>no</i> make-up tests available for late students.● You are required to abide by the policies of both the College Board and Olympic High School during the exam. Any misconduct will be reported and could jeopardize your AP Exam score.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● <u>Bring CELL PHONES, smart watches, or electronics (including watches with alarms/beepers).</u> Scores can be <i>invalid</i> if these are present.<ul style="list-style-type: none">-- The College Board reserves the right to <u>BAN</u> students from all future exams - AP, SAT, PSAT.-- Violations may affect college admission options.● Bring food or beverages (you may have a bottle of water and snack in a clear container - no labels - for break; it must be placed under your chair during exam)● Ask to be dismissed early.● Students <u>may not</u> be dismissed until the exam has officially ended; do not ask to leave if you finish early. <i>If you play a sport or have a job, it is your responsibility to inform your coach or employer of your AP Exam obligation, and arrangements should be made accordingly.</i>

SCORES:

- **Obtaining your AP Scores after the Exams: IT IS IMPORTANT TO KEEP YOUR STUDENT PACK ID # AFTER EXAMS. THIS IS HOW YOU WILL GET YOUR ONLINE SCORES IN JULY.** You will need to set up a College Board account, if you don't have one yet, to access your scores online at www.collegeboard.org
