**Seniors planning on walking in Commencement must be aware of the following information.**

- ✓ You must have earned the **CKSD required 22** credits and passed all required classes to graduate!
- ✓ You must have passed the **required state tests** (See your counselor for more information).
  - **Reading and Writing HSPE –or- English Language Arts SBA**
  - **Math EOC –or- Math SBA**
  - **Biology EOC**
- ✓ You must have completed your **High School and Beyond Portfolio** (see the Career Center for more information).
- ✓ **You must have cleared all fines.** Fine letters will be distributed to students during Tutorial at the end of May. Tickets to commencement will not be distributed to students or parent until **ALL FINES ARE CLEARED.**
  - Mrs. Kelstrup can only clear fines if you pay them!
- ✓ You must **attend required commencement practice(s)**. Make sure you clear your work schedule. If you don't attend practice(s), you don't walk in Commencement. Seating arrangements will be determined at practice.
- ✓ Practice on the day of graduation is a **"Dress Rehearsal"** and will be held in the President's Hall and Kitsap Pavilion.
