- You must have cleared all fines. Fine letters will be distributed to students during Tutorial at the end of May. Tickets to commencement will not be distributed to students or parent until ALL FINES ARE CLEARED.
 - Mrs. Kelstrup can only clear fines if you pay them!
- You must attend required commencement practice(s). Make sure you clear your work schedule.
