**AP Exam Payment Procedures for Students & Parents/Guardians**

Congratulations on accepting the challenge of the Advanced Placement Program at Olympic High School! An integral part of the AP curriculum is the culminating exam in May. **The annual testing period for the 2017 AP Exams will be May 1<sup>st</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> 2017.** An important consideration for families is the cost of taking the exams. Whether taking one test or several, planning ahead can help ease the stress on family budgets. This letter is intended to provide you with the ordering procedures and financial information necessary to plan for AP testing.

**Students must order and pay for exams in full by Thursday, March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017. The cost for each AP exam taken is \$93.00.** We must order the tests far in advance of the exam dates to ensure we have an accurate count and list of students taking each test *See information below regarding financial assistance requests.*

**Students can begin making payments in installments at the Cashier's window now up until the deadline.** Please take advantage of this option to pay for the tests over time so you are not caught off guard right before the deadline. You may also pay online at <https://touchbase.cksd.wednet.edu>, if paying for an exam in full (partial payments not accepted online), then you will need to submit your order forms at the Cashier Window. A \$15 test fee is required to order the test and is non-refundable; however, if a test is ordered but not taken, a student may request a refund of the \$78 balance through Mrs. Kelstrup, our ASB Secretary

  3. *Payment (unless paying online at <https://touchbase.cksd.wednet.edu/>)*
- ✓ **Please make payments by check payable to Olympic High School (OHS).** Be sure to write student name and test names on your check.
- ✓ **Final Deadline: Thursday, March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017:** All exams must be **ordered and paid in full** by this date.

**\*Financial Assistance Information\***

- **Students who currently qualify for Free or Reduced-Price Lunch:** Pay \$15 per exam with order forms. Online payment is not available.
- **Students who DO NOT qualify for Free/Reduced Lunch:** Indicate your interest on your order form and bring to your Counselor or AP Coordinator to discuss.
