- ☞ Log on to Moodle at www.moodle.cksd.wednet.edu
 - ☞ User name is student login
 - ☞ The first 7 letters of the last name
 - ☞ The last 4 digits of the student ID #
 - ☞ The first letter of the first name
 - ☞ The Password
 - ☞ First time users, use student ID #
- ☞ You will be prompted to immediately change your password
- ☞ Once in Moodle, click on the “Power School” link and you’re in!
